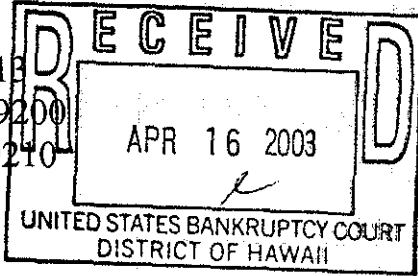


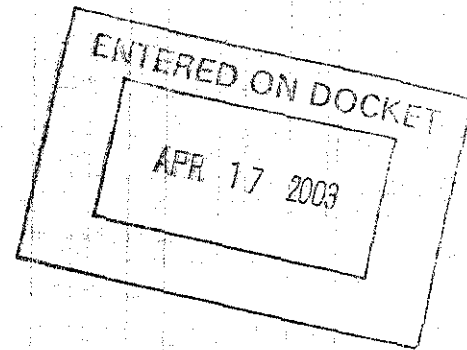

On March 21, 2003, Hawaiian Airlines, Inc. (the "Debtor"), debtor and debtor in possession in the above-captioned chapter 11 case, moved this Court for an order, pursuant to sections 105(a), 541 and 507(a)(8) of the Bankruptcy Code, authorizing the Debtor to Pay Prepetition Sales and Use Taxes, Transportation Taxes, Fees, Passenger Facility Charges and Other Similar Government and Airport Charges. At a hearing held on March 21, 2003, the Court granted the Motion and entered an order (the "Initial Order") on March 24, 2003, which provided that Parties In Interest had twenty (20) days from the date of entry of the Initial Order to file with the Court and serve upon the Debtor an objection to the Motion, and that if no objection to the Motion was filed and served within such time, the Initial Order would be deemed to be a final order. A further hearing on the Motion was held on April 15, 2003, at 9:30 a.m., at which the Court found that no objection to the Initial Order had been filed or served.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND  
DECREED THAT:

The Initial Order shall be deemed a final order.
