Upon the motion of Hawaiian Airlines, Inc. (the “Debtor”), the debtor and debtor in possession in the above-captioned chapter 11 case, for an order granting the Debtor a thirty (30) day extension to file its Schedules and Statement of Financial Affairs (the “Motion”); the Court finds that (i) it has jurisdiction over the matters raised in the Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (ii) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157(b)(2); (iii) the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor, its estate and its creditors; (iv) proper and adequate notice of the Motion and the hearing thereon has been given and that no other or further notice is necessary; and (v) upon the record herein, after due deliberation thereon, good and sufficient cause exists for the granting of the relief as set forth herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND  
DECREED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED in its entirety.
2. The Court hereby extends the fifteen-day period for the Debtor to file its Schedules and Statement of Financial Affairs pursuant to Rules 1007(a)(4) and 1007(c) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure for an additional thirty (30) days, so that such Schedules and Statement of Financial Affairs shall be due no later than May 5, 2003.
3. The relief granted in this Order is without prejudice to the Debtor's right to seek an additional extension to file its Schedules and Statement of Financial Affairs if cause so exists.
